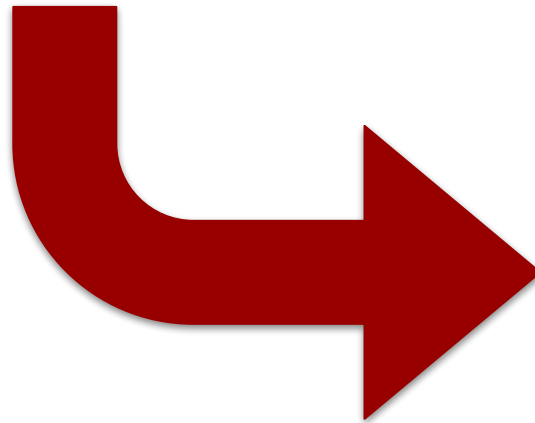
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Blending ^{FDC} Services

1. Understanding of course expectations
2. Communication/assessment
3. Personal connection
4. Lower cost/hour



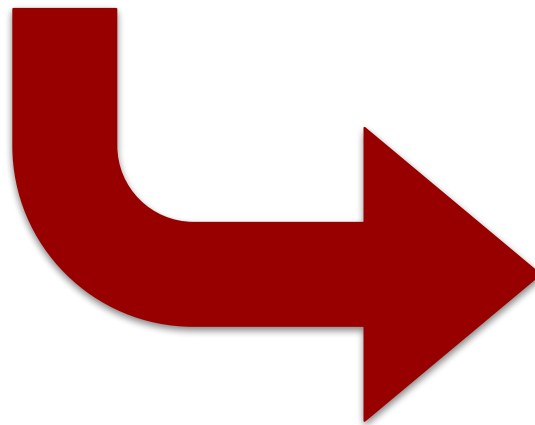
Application

1. Course specific guidance
2. Using non-verbal cues for struggling students
3. Environment of trust for ongoing support
4. Reducing overall tutoring support costs

Strength

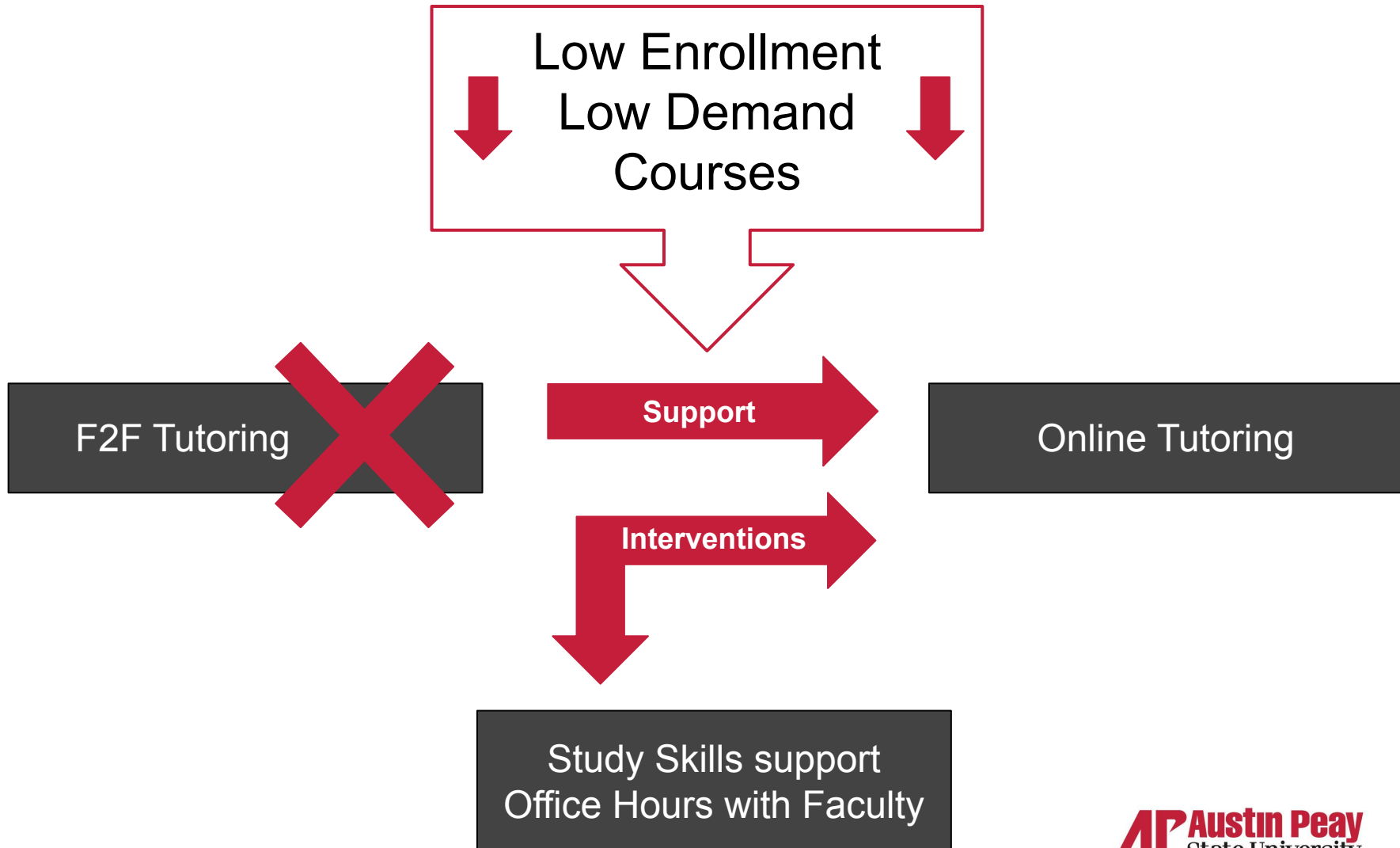
1. Ease of access

4. Administrator Alerts and Reporting



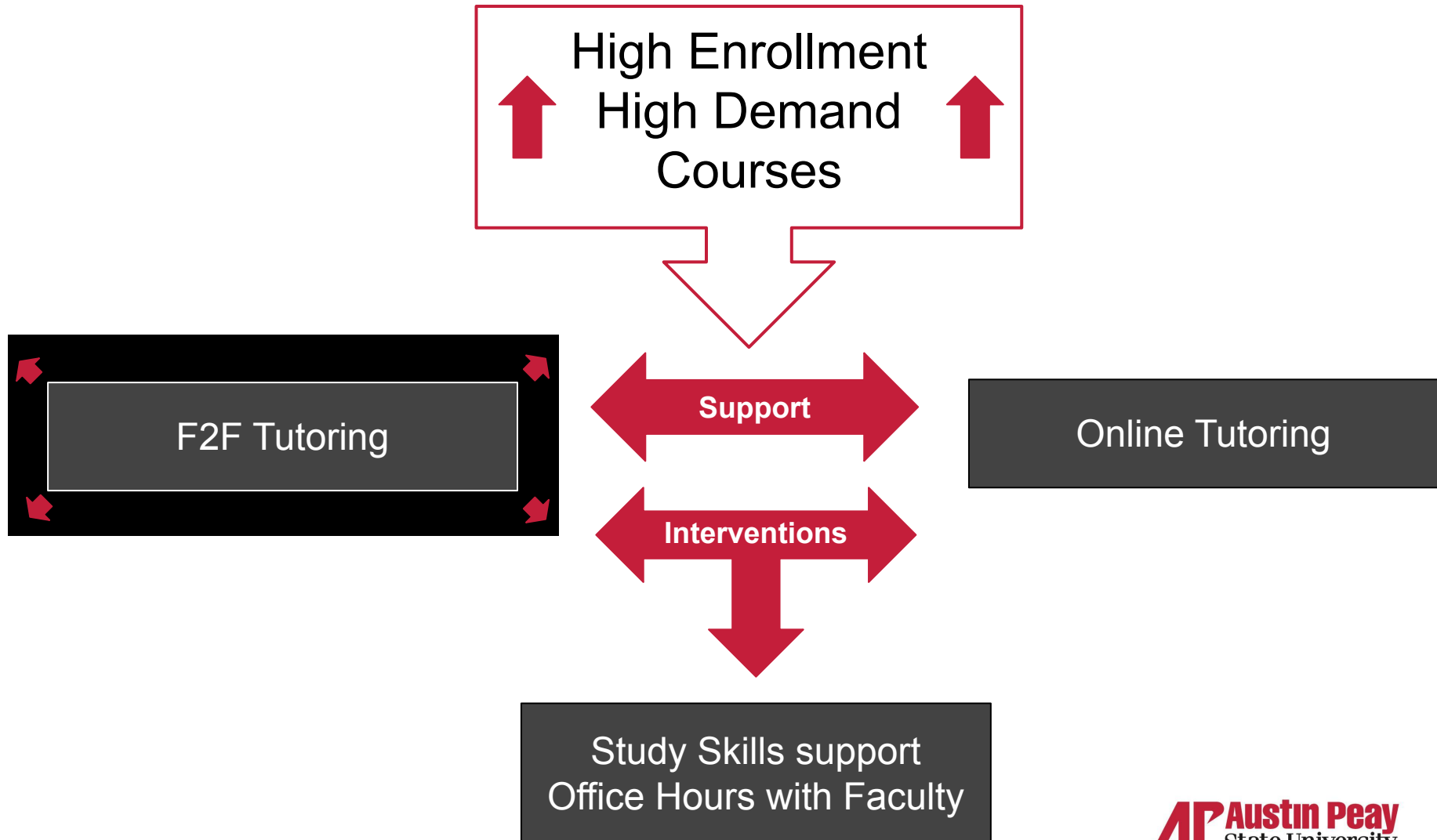
Application

1. Availability to a variety of students on demand
2. Decrease anxiety, increase likelihood of use
3. Increased breadth of support to students
4. Helps identify at-risk students

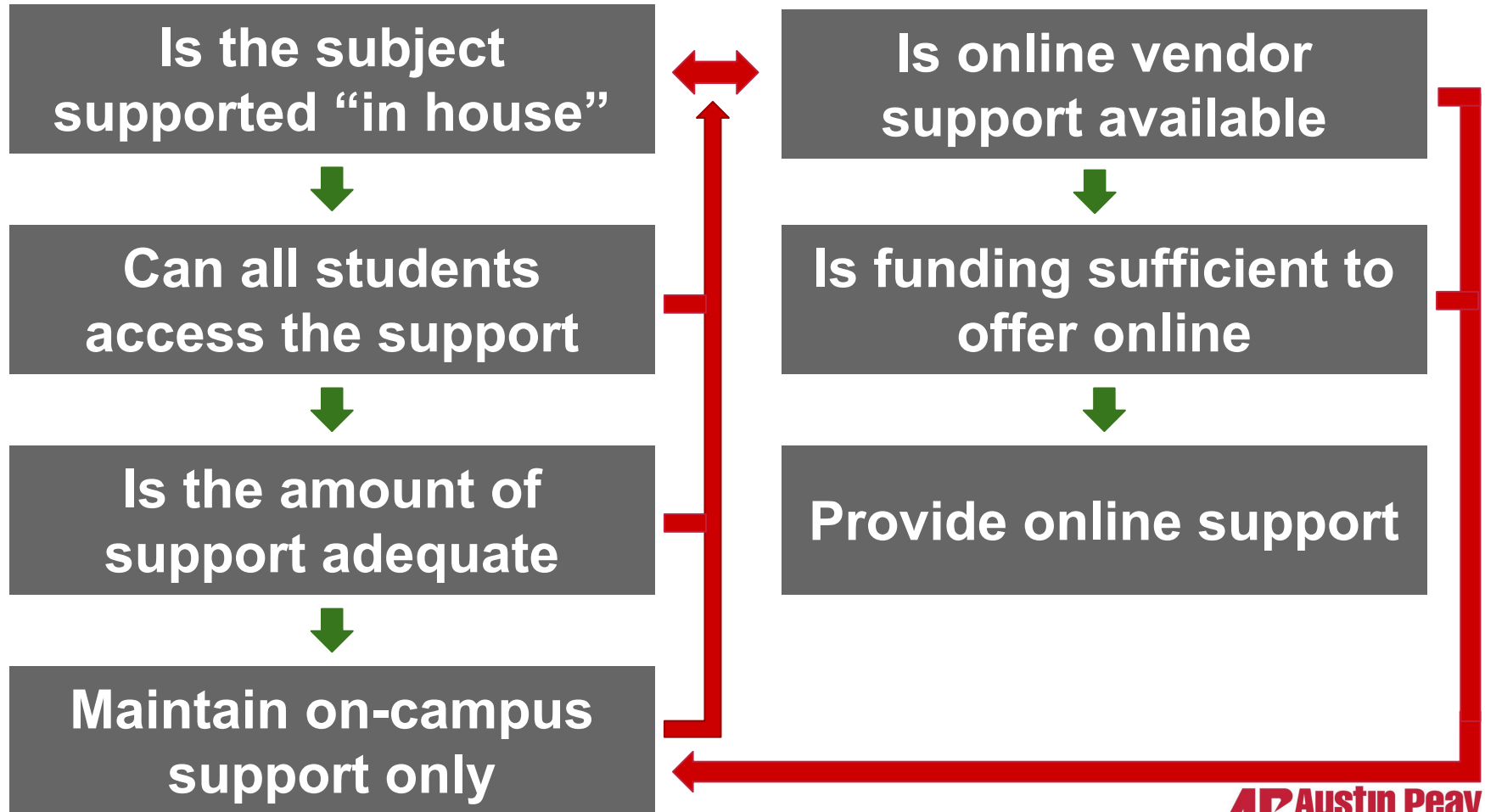

Example of Limiting 1

Situation: Online writing support was available through the Writing Center at a cost of \$9.00 per hour. Service has an average response time of less than 24 hours.

Solution: Online writing support continues to be provided by the Writing Center.

- Savings on \$19 per hour
- Tutors are familiar with expectations of professors
- Students receive timely, quality service

Example of Limiting 2

Situation: 5 hours of F2F ECON 2010 tutoring was available weekly, but typically, only 1 or 2 hours were used by students.

Solution: Eliminate F2F ECON 2010 tutoring and shift support to online tutoring. Shift the F2F hours previously allocated for ECON 2010 tutoring to MATH 1530 (Statistics) tutoring, a very high demand course.

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Sharing Responsibility


Funding

- Pilot: DE provided funds for pilot using left-over funds
- Data Collection:
 - Tutor.com provided initial estimates based on:
 - services requested
 - institution demographics
- Perpetual Funding: TAF
 - “This is exactly what TAF is for”
- Unused hours: All unused hours rollover to the next year

Key Points (cont.)

- Assess needs/wants before evaluating & selecting
- Be responsibly restrictive
 - Customization is key!
- Share Responsibility
 - Where can you find money for a pilot?
 - Who can you partner with to manage?
 - How can you leverage faculty-student connection?
