This year's Extravaganza shattered previous records, drawing in a staggering 187 classrooms from three states and captivating over 3,600 students. "Seeing the students' faces light up as they listened to the stories was truly magical," shared one participating reader. "It's a reminder of the power of storytelling to inspire, entertain, and connect us all."
